



HOMESCHOOL INFORMATION

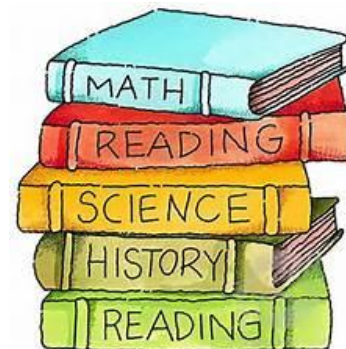
St. Mary's County Public Schools (SMCPS) and Calvert County Public Schools (CCPS) support home instruction in accordance with the [Code of Maryland Regulations \(COMAR 13A.10.01\)](#). The purpose of these regulations is to establish a procedure to be used to determine if a child participating in a home schooling program is receiving regular, thorough instruction during the school year in studies usually taught in the public school to children of the same age.

A parent or guardian who chooses to teach a child at home must complete a [Home Schooling Notification Form](#), initially and each year thereafter, to verify the continuation of home schooling. A parent or guardian needs to notify the Department of Student Services or their supervising nonpublic institution if there is a change in home schooling status during the school year.

The home schooling program must be under the supervision of either the student's local school system or a [nonpublic entity](#) that is registered with the Maryland State Department of Education ([MSDE](#)). The program shall be delivered by the parent or guardian and include instruction in English, mathematics, science, social studies, art, music, health, and physical education. A home schooling program under the supervision of the public school system (SMCPS or CCPS) will be reviewed by public school staff at the end of each semester. A home schooling program under the supervision of a nonpublic entity registered with MSDE will not be reviewed by SMCPS or CCPS.
