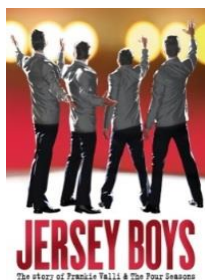

Jersey Boys

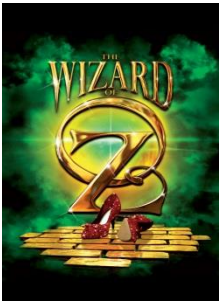

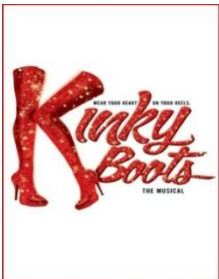

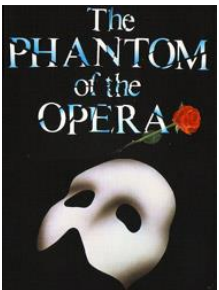
